January 28, 1922 - November 13, 2009

Lucille Shelton, 87, a 8 year Wenatchee resident and former resident of Yakima for 60 years, passed away on Friday, November 13, 2009 at Colonial Vista Care Center in Wenatchee.

She was born on January 28, 1922 at Mt. Vernon, Missouri to the late Otto and Emma Rose (Braden) Botts. She grew up and received her early education in Mt. Vernon, Missouri. She moved to Yakima when she was 18 and was later married to William Ray Shelton. They made their home together in Yakima where her husband worked as an Inspector for the railroad. Her husband was fatally injured in a railroad accident, which left her a widow at age of 24.
