Anna Mae McClun, 85, a Wenatchee resident for over 16 years, passed away at her home in Columbia Heights on Monday evening, July 18, 2011, following an extended illness.

She was born on February 18, 1926 at Taft, California to Chauncey Dow and Ada Mae (Notestine) Hendershott. She was raised in Taft and graduated from Taft High School in 1944. She continued her education at Woodbury College in Los Angeles.

Anna Mae married Robert Edwin "Rick" McClun at Taft, California in June of 1949. Together they made a number of moves in California that included Bakersfield, Visalia, and Granada Hills. Anna Mae worked along the way as a Medical Secretary at various hospitals, medical clinics and an orthodontist office.
