Anne M. Lattimer, 95, a resident of Wenatchee, passed away on July 30, 2012. She was born on May 10, 1917 at Salmon Arm, British Columbia, Canada to the late Eugene and Lillian (Cameron) Timpany. She was raised on the family farm the only girl reared with eight brothers.
