Argus Lee Hargrove, (Pee Wee, AL), 81, of Peshastin, went to be with his Lord and Savior on Saturday, September 19, 2009, Seattle, WA.

His life was a reflection of his faith. He was a devoted husband to Delores (Huckaby) for over 59 years, the loving father of James (Glenda), Evelyn (Randy Arnold), Jerry (Joyce); dedicated grandfather to 17 grandchildren and adoring great-grandfather for 8 boys and 3 girls.

He was born December 24, 1927 at Shamrock, Texas to William Ernest Hargrove and Nettie Florence Housewright. Pee Wee was the eldest of 8 siblings and the exemplary patriarch of the family. Pee Wee joined the U.S. Army Air Corp in 1945. Upon discharge, he worked as a Master Machinist all along the Pacific Coast, retiring from Alcoa in 1985. He remained busy fixing and creating various projects in his shop, hunting, fishing, camping, playing cards, teaching and loving his family.
