Arlene P. Martin, 87, a longtime Wenatchee and former longtime Quincy resident, passed away on December 23, 2012 at Central Washington Hospital.

She was raised and graduated from high school at Missoula and furthered her education at the University of Montana in Missoula. She graduated with a Bachelors degree in Business and Accounting and soon after found employment in Southern Idaho. She met and was later married to Harvey R. Martin in December of 1947 at Idaho Falls, Idaho. They made their home in the Nampa, Idaho area..
