She then enrolled in the nursing program at Gonzaga University in 1948, becoming the first of three women to attend Gonzaga and graduate with a degree as a registered nurse.

While attending Gonzaga, Barbara met the love of her life, Jack Brundage, who was home on leave from the Marine Corps. It was love at first sight. They were married for 69 beautiful years.

After their children, Linda and Debbie were born, Jack and Barb decided to sell their business, Columbia Construction, and move to Leavenworth, WA. There, Jack started working for the Chelan County PUD, and Barb worked at Cascade General Hospital and eventually St. Anthony's Hospital in

Wenatchee.

Later in life, the girls graduated, moved out, and started their own lives. Jack and Barb could retire and start a new chapter in their lives, which was beautiful and never dull. They built their dream home at Bayern Village, bought a motor home, and traveled extensively throughout Canada, the United States, and Mexico. They stayed for a time in San Felipe and loved it so much that they purchased a winter home on the ocean. They eventually sold and purchased a winter haven in Yuma, AZ.

Faith was a very important part of Barbara's life. She was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church. Mom never missed mass. Even when traveling, Dad always found the Catholic church, so Mom could attend mass.
