



Bonnie V. Andruss

April 13, 1929 - July 14, 2011

Bonnie V. Andruss, 82, of East Wenatchee, a 67 year Wenatchee area resident, passed away at her home on Thursday afternoon, July 14, 2011, following a brief illness.

She was born on April 13, 1929 at Melbourne, Arkansas to the late John Henry and Mary Adella (Walker) Troxler. She was raised and schooled in the Melbourne area prior to moving with her family to the Wenatchee area. She went to work in the area orchards before becoming a waitress at the Coney Island Café in Wenatchee. She met and was married to Justin Homer "Jack" Andruss on November 16, 1944 in Wenatchee, where they made their first home together.

Bonnie continued to work at the café prior to going to work for Cedergreens. She became a Supervisor and remained at Cedergreens through owner changes to retire in the early 1990's from Simplot.

Bonnie and Jack moved to make their home in East Wenatchee in 1976 where they remained. On September 9, 1996, she was preceded in death by her husband, Justin H. "Jack" Andruss. She has since continued to make her home in East Wenatchee.
