Carl Edward Brandt, "Pa Hat", 82, of Rock Island passed away on Saturday evening, July 28, 2012.

He was born on September 12, 1929 on Hice's Hill in Bridgeport, Washington to the late Howard Francis and Grace Mabel (Jackson) Brandt. He was raised on Pearl Hill east of Bridgeport. He attended school at the Del Rio School and went to work on the family wheat farm.
