



Charles "Chuck" F. Gibbs

December 20, 1925 - September 29, 2009

Charles F. "Chuck" Gibbs, 83, an East Wenatchee resident for over 75 years, passed away on Tuesday, September 29, 2009 at Central Washington Hospital.

He was born on December 20, 1925 at Colville, Washington to the late Raymond and Vern Gibbs. At an early age he moved with his family to the Baker Flats area of East Wenatchee where they homesteaded. He began driving farm and cattle trucks at the age of twelve. He became a commercial truck driver and started driving cattle for Wenatchee Packing Company. He met and later was married to Jacqueline J. Dyer on May 21, 1949 in Wenatchee. They made their home together in East Wenatchee.

He worked hauling steel for R & R Transportation and Reid and Son Trucking Companies for many years. Most recently he had worked driving trucks for Stemilt Growers before retiring in the early 1990's.

They have continued to make their home in East Wenatchee since he retired. He is survived by his wife of 60 years, Jacqueline "Jackie" Gibbs, East Wenatchee; three daughters and two sons-in-law, Cindy & Jimbo Turner, of Oregon, Terry & Bob Steel, Wenatchee and Leslie Beardslee, East Wenatchee; 7 grandchildren and 4 great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents, four sisters, Fern Gibson, Nellie, Ida Coxwell & Dot Buckley; two brothers, Ray Gibbs & Johnny Gibbs and one granddaughter, Noel Olsen.
