



## Clouie Lee Greenway

March 5, 1951 - May 21, 2011

Clouie Lee Greenway, 60, a longtime Central Washington resident, passed away on Saturday, May 21, 2011 at Highline Care Center in East Wenatchee, following an extended illness.

She was born on March 5, 1951 in Wenatchee to the late Edward and Patsy (Ashum) Hart. She moved as young child to Priest River, Idaho where she received her elementary and high school education.
