Conrad Amavisca, 74, passed away on May 1, 2026, comfortably in his home surrounded by loved ones including his service dog, Lucy. Conrad was born to Arthur and Guadalupe Amavisca on January 27, 1952, in Hanford, CA. He grew up in Kerman, CA.

In 2003, he answered his daughter's call for help and relocated to Wenatchee, WA, to help care for his granddaughter. His son, Rick, and his family soon followed. Finally, his kids and grandkids were all in the same town. He made Wenatchee his home. While remaining close to his family, he made numerous friends and enjoyed exploring his new stomping grounds: taking long drives, listening to music and enjoying the company he kept. He helped his community by volunteering at the local food bank.

Conrad worked as a forklift operator trainer. He was a strong and compassionate presence, often finding the humor in almost any situation, reminding us that life was serious enough. He loved to laugh, share stories, and listen to music. He was happy helping others whenever he could. More than anything he lived his life on his terms and he went out the same way. The independence to do and go anywhere at whatever time and pace he chose was important to him; joking and laughing and sharing pearls of wisdom from his own experiences along the way. Conrad was most proud of his two children and his three grandchildren. None of which he would hesitate to help

wherever needed.

While in school for Industrial Arts, he was drafted and served 15 years in the National Guard. He enjoyed working with his hands and creating things out of wood: shelves, boxes, cabinets, and often looked back fondly of time spent helping his parents and siblings build a home that remains in our family to this day. Another fond memory Conrad carried with him was working on his son's '73 Chevy Nova with both of his kids at one time or another.

Conrad was preceded in death by both parents; older brother, Arturo Amavisca; and son, Conrad "Rick" Amavisca. He is survived by his daughter, Corina Heath (née Amavisca); three grandchildren: Conrad Sebastian Amavisca, Phoebe A. Amavisca and Lynina J. Amavisca; younger brother, Geronimo "Jerry" Amavisca; sisters: Barbara Arredondo and Zenaida "Sandie" Bustamante; and numerous nieces, nephews, and cousins.
