Daniel E. "Dan" Long, 49, a longtime Wenatchee Valley resident, passed away on Thursday, March 17, 2011 at Central Washington Hospital, following an extended illness.

He was born on February 15, 1962 at Saint Anthony's Hospital in Wenatchee to Lin E. and Beverly (McDowell) Long. He was raised in Wenatchee and spent a brief periods of his youth in Harrington, Washington and Wurtzburg, Germany. He returned to Wenatchee where he attended Pioneer Middle School and Wenatchee High School. He graduated in the class on 1981 and following his graduation, he entered the U.S. Navy.
