May 25, 1961 - March 7, 2011

David Ray Marquis, 49, a 28 year East Wenatchee resident, passed away at his home in East Wenatchee on Monday morning, March 7, 2011, following an extended illness.

He was born on May 25, 1961 at Fort Lawton, Washington, the son of Richard and Veda (Epperson) Marquis. He spent his first three years growing up in Honolulu, Hawaii before his family moved to Yakima. He attended the Broadway and Stanton Elementary schools, Lewis and Clark and Eisenhower High Schools and the J.M. Perry Technical College in Yakima. He was married to Patricia M.
