Deborah Diane Baccus passed away November 13th at 4:15 am at her home she shared with her son. She was 65 years old.

Bob and Aletha Howe had Debbie on December 23rd, 1955. She was born and raised in Seattle, WA. She graduated from Evergreen High School.

Debbie married Daniel Robert Baccus September 24th, 1976. She later gave birth to Tamara Rene Baccus April 1st, 1977. Debbie and Dan divorced October 12th, 1977, but they always remained good friends. Debbie later met her common law husband Forrest Gene Spaulding. They had a son Kyle Steven Spaulding born February 24th, 1983. Shortly after Kyle's birth, they moved their family to Cashmere where they raise their children.

Forrest Gene Spaulding passed away November 4th, 1993. Debbie worked at TreeTop for many years. Then she went through training and became a mail carrier in Wenatchee, then later transferred to Leavenworth, where she worked for nearly 30 years. She retired from the Post Office December 28th, 2017.

We found Debbie had terminal pancreatic cancer June 19th, 2019. Doctors told her she had 6 months to a year to live. She fought hard to beat it - we were fortunate to have had her for almost 2 ½ more years after diagnosis.

Debbie is survived by her daughter Tami: and her family (husband Linh, son Kyle and his wife Kim and their precious daughters: Savannah Rose, Harper Rene, and Jacklynn Marie) of East Wenatchee; her brother Mike Howe of Granite Falls; brother Brad Howe and his family (wife Liza and their children: Alysha and Brandon) of Covington; nephew Erik Knowles and his family (girlfriend Shannon and their children: Cheyenne, Abdule, and Adam) of Auburn.
