Delbert "Beau" Earl Williams, 75, a resident of Wenatchee WA since 1969, passed away Wednesday, June 18th, 2014 at Cashmere Convalescent Center. Beau was born February 5, 1939 in Illinois to Vermont and Margret Williams. He was one of four children. Beau received his education in Hume, IL; where he enjoyed playing on the school's basketball teams. After graduating he enlisted in the US Army, serving two years in Korea.
