December 23, 1946 - August 24, 2014

Dennis Jay White, 67, East Wenatchee and a lifelong Wenatchee Valley resident, passed away at his home on Sunday, August 24, following an extended illness.

He was born on December 23, 1946 in Wenatchee, to John "Jake and Rena "Fay" (Dillard) White. Dennis was raised in Wenatchee, attended Lincoln Elementary, Pioneer Middle School and graduated from Wenatchee High School in 1965. He went to work at Alcoa until entering the US Army in 1969. Dennis served two years in Germany, where he was a chauffeur and supply clerk. Upon discharge he returned to the valley and continued his employment with Alcoa. Dennis married Teresa Marie Padoshek on August 2, 1980 in Wenatchee where they make their home until 1999 when they moved to East Wenatchee. He retired in 2001 with 35 years at Alcoa.

Dennis was a member of the Aluminum Glass and Brick Workers Union, and former member of FOE 204.

A natural musician that played by ear he mastered the guitar, accordion, trumpet and drums. His intelligence of electronics was evident in his BOSE stereo and electronic gadgets that he surrounded himself with. He loved to ride motorcycles, and missed his beloved 70 Chevelle that he only owned for a short time.

He was preceded in death by his infant son, Mark White and brother, Terry White, grandparents and an aunt.

Dennis is survived by his wonderful wife of 34 years, Teresa White, East

Wenatchee; parents, Jake & Fay, White and sister, Rena`e Shales, all of Wenatchee.
