Diana Lynn Sarvis, 56, a Wenatchee Valley resident for over 40 years, passed away on Thursday, March 2, 2017 at her home in Wenatchee, following an extended illness.

She was born on March 14, 1960 at Loris, South Carolina to the late Bobby Gene and Paula Ray (Goman) Sarvis. She was raised and attended schools in Loris, South Carolina. Her father was killed in an automobile accident in December of 1974 and her mother moved the family to East Wenatchee in the spring of 1975. Her mother was her best friend and her family was her priority.
