



Douglas L. Faulkner

August 27, 1940 - September 25, 2010

Douglas L. "Doug" Faulkner, 70, a 7 year Coulee City, Washington resident, passed away at Central Washington Hospital in Wenatchee on Saturday, September 25, 2010.

He was born on August 27, 1940 at Salt Lake City, Utah to Charles and Dortha (Taylor) Faulkner. He was raised and graduated from high school in Salt Lake City and further his education at Brigham Young University. He entered and served in the U.S. Air National Guard. Following his honorable discharge, he went to work at British Motor Cars Inc. in Seattle, where he was an Upholster. He met Jacqueline Jean Beyeler in Seattle and they were later married on April 16, 1976 at Shoreline, Washington. They made their first home together in Seattle, later moving to Mill Creek. They remained at Mill Creek for 8 years before moving to the Arlington area where they made their home for the next 17 years.

Doug went to work for the Boeing Aircraft Company in 1976, where he worked in the VIP Department, customizing jet airplane interiors. He retired in 2003 and they moved to make their home in Coulee City.

He was a longtime member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints and was currently a member at Coulee Dam, Washington.
