Edith Pearl (Walmer) Irmer, 94, a longtime Waterville resident, passed away peacefully in Waterville, WA, on Saturday, November 17, 2018. She was born on November 28, 1923, in Twisp, WA, to Charles and Alice (Cumbo) Walmer. Edith later moved with her family to Waterville, where she graduated from Waterville High School. She met and was later married to Walter C. Irmer, a local Farmer, on January 19, 1944, in Coeur d'Alene, Idaho. They made their home together on their wheat and cattle ranch located East of Waterville.

They operated their farm together until she was preceded in death by her husband, Walt on January 1, 2009. She remained on the farm a total of 66 years prior to moving into Amber Waves in Waterville.

She was a member of the Douglas County Wheat Wives and helped make cinnamon rolls for the fair for many years.

One of her hobbies was working with beads and making jewelry and Christmas ornaments for everyone. She also loved to crochet, but macular degeneration took most of her eyesight, so she had to quit beading while

continuing crocheting for many years by feel until she became unable.

Her boys loved her cooking especially her BIG thick chocolate chip cookies. She made them big so they could say they ate just one not 3 or 4.

Edith is survived by four sons and daughter-in-laws, Neil & Becky Irmer, Waterville, Wayne & Barbara Irmer, Spokane, Russell & Brenda Irmer and Leo & Catherine Irmer, all of Waterville; nine grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, Walt, in 2009 and three sisters: Lucille Rieve, Irene Driver and Bessie Sprague.

A Funeral Service will be held on Monday, November 26, 2018, at 11:00 a.m. at the Waterville Federated Church, 220 W. Ash Street, Waterville, WA., with the Reverend Seth Normington officiating. The interment will follow in the Waterville Cemetery, after which a reception will be provided at the church.
