



## Ellen Rae Kinamon

November 2, 1943 - August 17, 2012

Ellen Rae Kinamon, 68, a lifetime Wenatchee area resident, passed away at her home in Wenatchee on Friday, August 17, 2012.

She was born on November 2, 1943 in Wenatchee, WA, daughter of the late Rex and Lois (Searles) Kish. She was raised and attended Cashmere schools; graduating from Cashmere High School in 1961. She continued her education at Wenatchee Valley College, graduating with an AA degree.

She met and was later married to Dennis Kinamon, they made their home together in Cashmere and in 1970 moved to Wenatchee, and together they had a son, Jeff. After college she worked for the Selective Service until it closed and then she worked for the USDA. She went to work for the U.S.

Forest Service in mid 60's, as a Procurement Technician, in the Supervisors Office and then later relocated to the Easy Street office. She retired in December of 2011 after 43 years of service with the Federal Government.

She was a member of the Cashmere American Legion Auxiliary, Unit 64. Her hobbies included playing BINGO with her family and friends and ceramics.

She is survived by her son, Jeff Kinamon, (Wenatchee); sisters, Bev Lobe, and Phyllis Flagel, both of Cashmere and brother, Roy Kish, Marysville, WA plus several nieces and nephews.
