Ethel L. Grier, 96, of East Wenatchee, passed away on Monday, May 2nd at Souve Adult Family Home in Wenatchee.

She was born on December 25, 1914 in Tonasket to the late Hjalmer and Gertrude (Andersen) Figenshow. She was raised and schooled and graduated from the Tonasket High School in 1933.
