



Harold Edwin Armann

January 26, 1933 - April 28, 2014

Harold Edwin "Ed" Armann Jr, 81, a 25 year resident of East Wenatchee, passed away on Monday, April 28, 2014 following an extended illness. He was born on January 26, 1933 at Pomona, California to the late Harold Edwin "Dek" Sr. and Marvel Beatrice (Ellis) Armann. As a child he was raised in the Casper and Glenrock area. He graduated from the Glenrock-Parkeston High School with the class of 1952. He went to work in the oil field until 1956 then he married Margaret Julia MaGee on August 21, 1956 they made their home in Craig CO and together they raised four children, Mary B, Deborah, Horace "Ace" and Patrick "Pat". He worked for an oilfield supply company, National Supply Company. In 1961 they moved to Casper, Wyoming where Ed was employed by Northern Machinery Caterpillar Distributors and Repair Company and then in 1964 they moved to Midwest Wyoming. It is there that he worked for Doc Schidler Company and ran a service station, later for GRAMCO, a service station and bulk plant delivery company. Not long afterwards Ed decided to break out on his own and started "Rimrock Service" in Midwest, he worked as owner, manager and mechanic until 1989. The family moved to East Wenatchee in 1989 and purchased "Woody's Cab" and opened a second company, "AAA Cab", in September 1998 they reorganized and started "A Cab". In 2011 Ed stepped down due to health issues and turned the keys over to his children, Mary B and Pat.

When Ed wasn't busy driving he loved to golf and participate in league bowling and his family refers to him as an "avid Steelers' fan". He was a

former longtime member of the Salt Creek Lions Club in Midwest-Edgerton, Wyoming.

He is preceded in death by his parents; sister, Donna Lee Armann and step father, Horace Greeley McMurry.

Ed leaves behind his wife of 57 years, Margaret Armann, East Wenatchee; four children, Mary Beatrice Armann, East Wenatchee, Deborah (Mike) Wahl, Loveland, CO, Horace "Ace" Armann, Sheridan, Wyoming, Patrick "Pat" (Misty Abbott) Armann, East Wenatchee; brother, Scott McMurry, Edgerton, Wisconsin; seven grandchildren and three great grandchildren.

A Memorial Mass service will be held on May 9, 2014 at Holy Apostles Catholic Church in East Wenatchee at 2:30pm.
