As a very young man Harold served in the U.S. Army Infantry during World War II in the Asiatic Pacific and Korea.

After his military service he became a member of The Salvation Army. In 1963 he was commissioned as a Salvation Army Officer. During a long career as an officer he and his wife served in the Salvation Army Men's Rehabilitation Program, then as Corps Officers (Pastors) in various locations throughout the Western States.

They officially retired in 1993 and made their home in Cashmere but continued to serve in Washington and Alaska as needed.

He is survived by Dorothy, his wife of 55 plus years, his children, grandchildren, extended family as well as many to whom he was beloved pastor and friend.

He was known for his kind heart and great sense of humor.
