Helen Ramirez-Myers, 96, a longtime Wenatchee Resident, passed away on Friday evening, December 30, 2016 at Regency Manor in Wenatchee. Born on November 3, 1920 at Wenatchee to the late August and Ada Bess (Fraley) Sachs; Helen was raised and received her education in Wenatchee, graduating from WHS with the Class of 1940. After graduation, she went to work at the Cascadian Hotel as a Cashier and Desk Clerk. Helen met Norbert Ramirez and they were later married on August 11, 1944 in Everett, WA. They made a number of moves throughout the United States and Germany during her husband's career as a Colonel in the Air Force. In 1953, she came back to Wenatchee to raise her family, and resumed working at the Cascadian Hotel in the late 1950's. She met Roy Myers and they married in 1970. In 1973, they moved to Las Vegas and she gained employment at the MGM Grand Hotel. Shortly after Roy's death, she returned to Wenatchee where her family resided.

Helen was a volunteer in the Orthopedic Hospital Guild and a member of the Bridge Club. She enjoyed shopping, making lampshades and loved her dog "Star" but most of all she enjoyed having family and friends over to her home. She is survived by her daughters, Sue (Pat) Robertson and Diana "Di" Ramirez-Ogee, both of East Wenatchee; seven grandchildren, Joe (Desha) Furin, Anacortes, Brandi (Rob) Hedlund, Ginger Roberts, Sundi (Luis) Perez, Craig (fiancé, Victoria Kern) Robinson, Laura (Helen) Mitchell and Darren Robertson all of East Wenatchee and 12 great grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her parents, husbands, Norbert Ramirez and Roy Myers; grandson, Brandon Luis Perez and brothers, Morris August Sachs and Howard Thomas Sachs.
