Inge Breiler, 85, longtime Badger Mountain resident, passed away on Sunday, August 26, 2018.

She was born on January 28, 1933, at Mainz, Germany, to the late Emil and Anna (Landek) Gelsebach. She was raised and received her schooling in Germany. She married a serviceman, Lynn Madson, in Frankfort, Germany, and in 1952 they moved to the United States, settling on Badger Mountain. Together they helped operate the Madson family wheat ranch. Lynn preceded her in death in 1952 and she remained on the mountain. In 1954, she married Earl Breiler in Wenatchee, WA, and they made their new home on the Breiler Ranch on Badger Mountain. Inge became a ranch wife and not only raised her four sons, but also helped out on the farm. She was preceded in death by her husband, Earl, on March 16, 2005. She remained on the ranch until April of 2018.

Inge enjoyed traveling by car, going lake fishing, and was on a women's bowling league.
