February 4, 1953 - August 10, 2011

James Wesley "Jimmy" Hamilton, 58 a one year East Wenatchee resident and former longtime Coeur d' Alene, ID resident, passed away on Wednesday, August 10, 2011 at Central Washington Hospital, following an extended illness.

He was born on February 4, 1953 at Tacoma, Washington to the late Thomas Warren & Elinor Mae (Nilsen) Hamilton. His early education took place in Millard Elementary in Spokane, prior to the family moving to the Seattle area. He graduated from the DeMoines High School in 1971 and a short time later, he moved to make his home in Coeur d'Alene, ID. He was employed as a cook at Denny's Restaurant and later became an equipment maintenance man for the Kentucky Fried Chicken Franchise. He went to work as a fiberglass fabricator at Eunique Fiberglass & Fabrication in Post Falls ID and was later transfer to Henderson, NV. He returned to Coeur d' Alene briefly in the mid 1990's, prior to moving to Ketchikan, Alaska where he worked on boats. He later moved to Billings, MT where he remained for three years prior to returning to Coeur d'Alene. His last year was spent in East Wenatchee where he was able to be close to his family. He was a waterskiing enthusiast, having learned at the age of 4, and loved fishing.

He is survived by two brothers and sisters-in-law, Thomas Michael & Sherry Hamilton of Malaga, WA and John Robert & Toni Hamilton of Cathedral City, CA, 4 nieces, 3 nephews and 5 cousins.

He is preceded in death by his parents.
