James Elmo Henry, 75, a 55 year Wenatchee area resident and a 38 year Chelan resident, passed away at his home on Wednesday evening, May 16, 2012, following an extended illness.

He was born on December 20, 1936 at Lakeview, Texas to the late James Aubrey and Mayme (Sheppard) Henry. He was raised in Texas to the age of 16 prior to the family moving to Monitor. He attended Cashmere High School. He worked in the local warehouses as a Refrigeration Engineer, retiring from Trout Blue Chelan, in January of 2000 after 20 years.

He met Janet Sims in Cashmere in 1962 and they were married on December 20, 1962, in Wenatchee. They made their first home in Cashmere before moving to East Wenatchee in 1969. They moved to Chelan in 1974 where they have since remained.

He attended the North Shore Bible Church in Chelan.

He is survived by his wife of 49 years, Janet Henry, Chelan; their three children, Cari McLaren and Bret Henry both of Chelan and Irene (Wayne) Frei, Coeur d'Alene, ID; 7 Grandchildren.
