February 2, 1931 - May 9, 2016

Jane Elizabeth Render, 85, a resident of the Wenatchee valley since 1951, passed away on May 9, 2016.

She was born on February 2, 1931 at Newark, New Jersey to the late Ralph and Christine (Kitzmocher) Averill and until the age of 12 she was raised and attended school there. The family moved to Milford, Michigan where she finished her education and she met and married Thomas Render. Jane and Thomas moved their family to Wenatchee and she found a housekeepers job at Lyles Motel. Jane then embarked on a career as a cook, starting at the A&W Drive In and then the Wenatchee School District at Orchard Middle School before ending up at Mission Vista Group Home in East Wenatchee. In the 1990's Jane commuted (before moving) to Quincy daily to operate the Quincy Senior Center, where she oversaw the operations the Gift Shop, activities, kitchen and anything else between. In 2001 she moved back to Wenatchee and lived at the Deaconess Apartments.

Jane was a member of the Wenatchee and Quincy First Assembly of God churches, and the Quincy Senior Center. She enjoyed working with flowers, visiting her son's farm and loved angels.

She is preceded in death, her husband; sons, Joseph and Martin Render; sisters, June Delisle and Barbara Jensen; brothers, Tom and Duane Averill and grandsons, Eric and John J. Render.
