September 23, 1918 - September 30, 2012

Jane Scheble, 94 a longtime resident of Wenatchee passed away peacefully on Sunday evening at Dore' Adult Family Home in East Wenatchee. She was born on September 23, 1918 in Racine Wisconsin to Frank and Edna Louise (Dahl) Sorley.

Jane moved with her family to Wenatchee at a very early age and attended Wenatchee schools and graduated from WHS in 1936. She continued her education at the University of Washington where she received a BA and was a member of the Chi Omega Sorority. She returned to Wenatchee and married Frank M. Scheble on September 23, 1943.

Jane loved entertaining and socializing with her countless friends. She was a lifelong member of the Wenatchee Golf and Country Club and an avid bridge player. She also gave back to the community by being involved as a member of the Wenatchee Hospital Guild and helped organize the very first Follies in 1948. There is nothing she enjoyed more than laughing and spending quality time with friends and family.

She is survived by her daughter, Sally Caraher, Wenatchee; one son and daughter-in-law, Mike & Diane Scheble, Seattle, and two grandchildren, Cory Molzahn, Seattle and Casey Caraher, Portland Oregon. She was preceded in death by her husband Frank, and brother Mark Sorley.
