Jean Marie "Mom" Logan, 81, a lifelong Wenatchee Valley resident, passed away on Tuesday, October 30, 2012 at Central Washington Hospital, following a brief illness.

She was born on October 26, 1931 at Saint Anthony's Hospital in Wenatchee, the daughter of the late William and Mary (Paukowich) Schoenmakers. She was raised on Rock Island Road and received her elementary education in the old cannery schoolhouse. She later joined the Bridge Walkers while attending Wenatchee High School. She graduated from Wenatchee High School in 1949.

Later, during the 1970's, she became a Bartender at the Columbian Hotel prior to tending bar at Minn's Tavern in East Wenatchee during the 1980's. She had also tended the bar at the American Legion for a time. While working at Minn's, she became affectionately known as "Mom" to many customers. During the 1990's, she went to work at Stemilt Growers as a Fruit Pre-sizer. She remained at Stemilt until retiring in 2002. She moved to make her home in Garden Terrace in 2003.

Jean was an original bargain hunter. She enjoyed driving her sisters around and especially their trips to Mill Bay Casino together. She also made trips to the Anchorage and Eagle River area of Alaska and Paradise, California to visit her son's.

Jean is survived by seven sons and three daughters-in-law; Steve and Ron Logan both of Paradise, CA, Dan & Sylvia Logan, East Wenatchee, Tom
