Jeffery Dean "Jeff" Whitmire, 52, a lifetime Wenatchee valley resident, passed away suddenly at his home in Cashmere.

He was born on December 16, 1962 in Wenatchee to Franklin and Doris (Fisher) Whitmire. He was raised in East Wenatchee and attended East Wenatchee schools. He attended Eastmont High School and following high school, he went to work at Welch's in Wenatchee. He met and was later married to Sharon Weddle on November 24, 1984 in Wenatchee. They made their first home together in Wenatchee. In 1988, they moved to Clackamas, Oregon where he worked at the Fortifiber Company. He worked in custom plastic wrapping of homes and lumber.
