Jerry M. Schafer, 63, a Wenatchee resident for over 60 years, passed away on Saturday, December 9, 2017, at his home in Wenatchee.

He was born on September 24, 1954 in Bremerton, Washington to the late Harry William and Esther Astrid (Johnson) Schafer. They moved their family to Wenatchee when Jerry was three years old. He was raised in Wenatchee and attended Whitman Elementary, Orchard Middle School and Wenatchee High School. He graduated from Wenatchee High School in 1972 and shortly thereafter he went to work at France and Company as a General Laborer. He learned many trades and became an Independent House Painting Contractor. In the early 1990's, he formed a partnership with his brother, Erving, and they took over their father's landscaping business, known as "Mowtime Landscaping". Jerry has continued his work with yard care, landscaping, snow removal and sprinkler systems until ill health forced him to retire. He enjoyed his work so much that given the choice he would have most likely worked 24 hours a day.
