



## Jerry Allan Wheeler

January 23, 1960 - May 1, 2010

Jerry Allan Wheeler, 50, a lifelong Wenatchee resident, passed away on Saturday, May 1, 2010 at Central Washington Hospital.

Jerry was born on January 23, 1960 in Wenatchee the son of Gerald and Joyce (Henning) Wheeler. He grew up in the Sunnyslope area and attended Sunnyslope School. He later attended Orchard Jr. High School and Wenatchee High School, graduating in 1978. While Jerry was in high school, he was in a work study program and received some of his credits by working in the café at the Bus Depot.

He later went to work for K-Mart as a Stockman, prior to becoming a Rural Mail Carrier Substitute for the U.S. Postal Service. During the 1990 year, he worked for the Census Bureau. He went to work as a clerk at the Express lane Mini Mart and while working there he met, Gail M. Gagnon. They were married on May 15, 1993 in Wenatchee, where they made their home together. Together they started a computer consulting business, known as "G & J Computer Consulting". Jerry continued to operate their business. He was a member of the Church of Christ of Cashmere. He especially enjoyed camping, taking pictures, working on and fixing computers and computer problems.

He is survived by his wife, Gail M. Wheeler, Wenatchee; four children, Sylvia (Dave) Woods, East Wenatchee, Casey Wheeler, Peshastin, Wesley Stewart, Fort Collins, CO and Lyndsey (Brian) Theobald, Layton, UT; his parents, Gerald and Joyce Wheeler, Wenatchee, two brothers, Donald (Dianna)
