Jill Carol (Beasley) Davenport, 51, a nine year East Wenatchee resident, passed away at her home in East Wenatchee on Friday morning, May 7, 2010.

She was born on September 11, 1958 at Glendora, California, to Allen and Nancy (Robinson) Beasley. She was raised to the age of twelve at Mission Viejo, California before the family moved to McKenzie, Tennessee, where she graduated from the McKenzie High School in 1977. She was married to Charlie "Jackie" Davenport at McKenzie, Tennessee in September of 1976. They made some moves while her husband was in the military that included Charleston, South Carolina and San Antonio, Texas, prior to her returning to McKenzie, Tennessee in 1981. She made her home in the south until moving briefly to Seattle in 2000. She has resided with her Fiancée in East Wenatchee for the last nine years.

Jill was a meticulous housekeeper and a phenomenal cook.

She is survived by her Fiancée, Grant Huffman, East Wenatchee; her son, Trevor Davenport, Paris, Maine; her mother and step-father, Nancy and George Kometz, Wenatchee; two brothers, Thomas Beasley, Thai Chung, Taiwan and Brennan Beasley, Kent, Washington and one sister, Cara (Beasley) Nielsen, Flint, Michigan. She is also survived by her two pet Yorkie dogs, that were like daughters to her, Buggy and Bonnie.
