John D. Everhart, a longtime Wenatchee and East Wenatchee resident, passed away on August 9, 2010. In the loving arms of his daughter and family. He was born on April 24, 1924, at Bethany, Oklahoma, to the late Arthur Lee and Ida Malinda (Amstuz)Everhart.
