Julie Mae Pederferri, 73, of Wenatchee, a former longtime Sunland Estates and Renton resident, passed away on Thursday morning, March 3, 2016 at Yuma Regional Care Center in Yuma, Arizona, following a sudden illness. She was born on April 22, 1942 at Hoquiam, Washington to the late Howard and Sylvia (Farmen) Crippen. She was raised and graduated from high school at Elgin, Oregon. She later moved to make her home in Renton, Washington. While there, she met Harvey Pederferri and in the late 1960's, they made their home together. They were married on April 19, 1986. They continued to make their home together Renton until Harvey retired in 1994. They built their home at Sunland Estates that same year. They also began wintering in Yuma, Arizona. They moved into Wenatchee in 2011 and Harvey preceded her in death on December 31, 2012. She has since continued to make her home in Wenatchee and wintering in Yuma.

Julie was a member of Wenatchee Fraternal Order of Eagles #204 Auxiliary, a former member of the Quincy Moose Lodge, the Renton V.F.W. Auxiliary and the Sedro Wooley American Legion Auxiliary.
