



## June Williams

March 19, 1920 - July 19, 2010

Marion June Williams, 90, of Wenatchee, a former longtime Spokane area resident, passed away on Monday, July 19, 2010 at Highline Care Center in East Wenatchee.

She was born on March 19, 1920 at Strawberry Point, Iowa, to the late Myron James and Addie Ellen (Matthys) Burnside. The family moved to the Colville area when she was an adolescent and she attended schools in the Colville and Chewelah areas. While in Old Marcus, (a city later flooded by dam waters), she met Clifford Forest Williams and they were later married on November 1, 1939 at Colville. They made their first home together in the Evans Quarry area north of Colville, before moving to Old Marcus and Colville. The family made numerous moves while following Clifford's construction jobs that included much of eastern Washington and Montana. They later settled in to the Spokane area where they had lived in the Mead, Edgecliff and Post Falls areas. After retiring, they moved to the Mesa and Avondale areas of Arizona where they remained until returning to Spokane in 2007. She was preceded in death by her husband, Clifford Forest Williams in March of 2008. She has since made her home in Wenatchee.

She is survived by two daughters and son's-in-law, Claudia & Tex Alexander, Reardan, WA and Cheryl & Larry Witte, Wenatchee; one son and daughter-in-law, Clifford & Zana Williams, Surprise, AZ; five grandchildren, Tim Mellen, Spokane, Julie McLean, Vancouver, WA, Crystal Maginity, Avondale, AZ, Daryl Williams and Amber Corey both of Spokane; 7 great grandchildren and

1 great great grandchild. She was preceded in death by her parents, two sisters, Helen Salsman and Joyce Dotts and two brothers, Mike and James "Jim" Burnside.

At her request no formal services will be held. A family disposition ceremony will be held at a later date. Arrangements are in the care of Heritage Memorial Chapel, East Wenatchee.
