



## Kathryn Collie

November 20, 1918 - December 8, 2009

Kathryn Collie, 91, a 63 year Wenatchee Valley resident, passed away on Tuesday, December 8, 2009 in Wenatchee.

She was born on November 20, 1918 at Guion, Arkansas to the late Garland and Laura (Eary) Ward. She was raised in Arkansas and was later married to Ray Thomas Collie on October 20, 1934 at Guion, Arkansas. They moved to the Wenatchee area in 1946, settling first in the Palisades before moving to Wenatchee. Kathryn went to work in the late 1940's as a Waitress at the Cascadian Hotel Restaurant. During the early 1950's, she went to work at Claussen's Drug Store as a Cosmetician. She was in charge of all of the skin care, make up and perfume products. She went to work in the late 1960's at Stan's Merry Mart.

On February 28, 1970, she was preceded in death by her husband, Ray Collie. She continued to work at Stan's Merry Mart until retiring in the late 1980's.

She especially enjoyed her garden, cooking and canning and being at her home.
