



Kevin Neal Waterhouse

January 24, 1958 - March 2, 2012

Kevin Waterhouse, 54, a longtime East Wenatchee resident, passed away on Friday, March 2, 2012 from cancer.

Kevin was born the third child to Hal and Phyllis Waterhouse on January 24, 1958 in Wenatchee. He is survived by his mother, his three children, Jonathan (Mirella) Waterhouse, Cindy (Fernando) Garcia, and Mandy (Jake) Christiansen. He also leaves behind seven grandchildren; Alyssa Cortez, Brianna and Jayden Waterhouse, Kemberlee Garduno, Keven and Kasandra Garcia and Blake Christiansen.

He grew up in East Wenatchee and attended Eastmont Schools, graduating from Eastmont High School in 1977. There he enjoyed playing baseball, tennis, wrestling and downhill snow skiing. Immediately following graduation he entered the U.S. Army National Guard on June 19, 1977. He was stationed in Ephrata. He was married to Judy Diaz in the summer of 1979. They made their home together in Ephrata where he was serving on active duty. On August 16, 1979, he was shot at his residence and from his injuries, he later became permanently disabled. He had an honorable discharge on October 31, 1980.

Kevin moved his growing family to East Wenatchee where he began to work with his father, Hal Waterhouse in the family orchard. Kevin took pride in his family. He was and always will be, a loving father. He did the best he could but eventually his disability got the better of him. He resided in Puyallup where he was diagnosed with cancer. With his health deteriorating he transferred to

Columbia Crest Care and Rehabilitation Center in Moses Lake where he spent his final days.

He was preceded in death by his father, Hal Waterhouse.

A Commemoration Service will be held on Friday, March 9th at 10:00 a.m. at Heritage Memorial Chapel. Concluding services with Military Honors will follow in Evergreen Memorial Park, East Wenatchee.
