



Kyle Isaac Davis

August 17, 1922 - June 10, 2014

Kyle Isaac Davis, 91, a lifelong Wenatchee resident and longtime plumbing company owner, passed away on Tuesday, June 10, 2014 at his home with his family by his side.

He was born on August 17, 1922 at Wenatchee to the late Isaac and Ada (Petersen) Davis. He was raised in Wenatchee and graduated in 1941. He entered the US Army in January 1943 serving in the Asiatic Pacific Theater as a radio operator. Discharged in 1946 he returned to Wenatchee and then decided to attend Oregon Bible College, it is here that he met Mary Evelyn O'Neil while on a choir tour. They married on July 20, 1951 at South Bend, Indiana, returning to Wenatchee where they built their home on the families' property. Kyle went to work at Padashek Plumbing, eventually moving up as the main plumber. In time Kyle decided to open his own company, Do All Plumbing, which he worked at until retiring in his 80's.

Throughout his life Kyle shared his singing voice in a Christian quartet (along with his brothers) and was part of a Chorale Group and a Barber Shop Quartet. Kyle will always be remembered for singing "Loved". He was a longtime member of Church of God Faith of Abraham in Wenatchee.

Kyle was preceded in death by his parents; son, Russell Davis and brothers, Charles and Boyd Davis.

He leaves behind his wife of 62 years of marriage, Mary Davis, Wenatchee; five children, Miriam (Steve) Overland, Coram, Montana, Edward (Nita) Davis, Blair (Priscilla) Davis, Lisa (George) Dockins and Laura (Jay) Fulbright, all of

Wenatchee; Brother, Kirby (Bonnie) Davis, Wenatchee; 12 grandchildren and seven great grandchildren.
