Larry Homar Higdon, of Wenatchee, WA, passed away at his residence on May 5, 2026, at the age of 96. He was born to Harry and Amelia Maria Higdon, October 18, 1929, in Port Angeles, WA. He attended Port Angeles Schools, Class of 1947, and college at CPS (UPS) in Tacoma WA, where he studied journalism.

Larry worked for the Forestry Service and Crown Zellerbach Papermill on Ediz Hook, Port Angeles. He was a flight attendant for West Coast Airlines, later becoming Hughes Airwest, based out of Seattle, WA. He also was a truck driver and meat packer for Armour Meats, and a top salesman for Blake, Moffitt and Towne Paper Company in Seattle. He moved to Wenatchee, in 1969, and was a salesman for Sears Home Improvement and Wenatchee Truck and Auto. In 1998, he returned to Port Angeles and resided there until 2015, when he relocated back to Wenatchee to be in a more central location between his children.

Larry enjoyed planes, old cars, and especially baseball; playing throughout his school years and college. He played semi-pro baseball in the Puget Sound area and Canada. He loved a good game of golf and also partook in square dancing. He followed many sports teams and had immense sports knowledge. He was a member of the Fraternal Order of Eagles in both Port Angeles and Wenatchee.

Larry was preceded in death by his parents; and eldest son, Kelly Higdon. He is survived by his daughter, Tami (Ron) Morr; son, Christopher (Robyn) Higdon; daughter, Lisa (Eric) Faranda-Jenkins; grandsons: Tony (Latina) Faranda and Garret Higdon; and great-grandsons: Logan, Huey, and Jeff Faranda.
