



## Larry Eugene Tucker

April 3, 1942 - November 25, 2022

Larry Tucker, age 80 passed away peacefully at home after an extended battle with colon cancer on Friday, November 25th with his wife Janice and brother Jerry by his side

He was born in Seattle, WA on April 3rd, 1942 to Bert and Bertha (Kalles) Tucker, and spent his early years growing up in Leavenworth, later moving to East Wenatchee.

Larry graduated from Eastmont High in 1961 and joined the Naval reserves. He worked that summer tearing down the Holden Mines and went on active duty that fall serving 2 years active and another 6 years in the reserves. After his service, he marries Chris and they had two children, later divorcing.

He later met Janice in July of 1985 and were later married in May of 1993, celebrating 37 years together.

Larry held several jobs in his lifetime, working at Alcoa, working at the Malaga CO, and then retiring from Stemilt Growers after 21 years.

Larry was preceded in death by his parents Bert and Bertha Tucker, his son Scott, granddaughter Chyla and several aunts and uncles.

He is survived by his wife Janice, brothers Jerry and Mike (Chris) and

daughter Teresa(Randy), grandsons Jonathan(Ashley), Jacob, Jackson, and Blaine (Ashlee), Aunt Sharon, several cousins, and extended family members.
