She loved her time there. She loved riding horses to bring in the milk cows and milk them as well as doing other chores. "Those were wonderful happy days in the Sandhills of Nebraska. Free to run and enjoy the Sandhills without fear. To wade in the creek and swim in the Snake River".

She graduated in 1942, from Valentine High School in Valentine NE. She met Wayne at the bowling alley, his folks had started and run the business. She invited him over for fried chicken dinner, they eloped and were married in St John's Episcopal Church in Valentine NE on April 24, 1952.

They moved to Wenatchee, Washington in November of 1952. Wayne then moved the family to Quincy WA in 1962, and they remained there until moving back to Wenatchee in 1995. They moved to East Wenatchee in 2009. She then moved back to Quincy in 2022 until her death.

She was active in Eastern Star, Rainbow for Girls, Girl Scouts, and Amaranth. She started as a bank teller in Valentine, then in Wenatchee, as well as Quincy. She ran the office at Nexus AG Chemicals until she went to work as the Municipal Court Clerk in Quincy, until her retirement. She was very much into crafts and as well her family. She enjoyed and celebrated the holidays with vigor.
