Lisa Joy Carrier, 51, of Wenatchee, a former longtime Tacoma and Gig Harbor resident, passed away on Friday, January 6, 2012 at Central Washington Hospital, following an extended illness.

She was born on November 11, 1960 in Wenatchee, to Arthur Sherman and Harstine Joy (Moser) Horner. She was raised and educated in East Wenatchee and was in the first graduating class of the Christian Academy on Rock Island Road in East Wenatchee in 1979. She continued her education at Green River College near Auburn. She met and was later married to Kevin Carrier. They made their home together in Tacoma and the Gig Harbor areas. They co-owned and managed a landscaping business prior to her continuing her education at the University of Washington, Tacoma Campus. She graduated with a Bachelor's degree in Education and worked as a Teacher's Aid and a Substitute Teacher, prior to ill health forcing her to retire. She was briefly married to Mark Smith and upon their dissolution; she returned her last name to Carrier. She returned to make her home in Wenatchee in 2009 and has since continued to make her home here. Lisa attended the Free Methodist Church in Wenatchee and had gone on mission trips to Mexico with the church. She enjoyed reading, studying the bible, camping trips, the out of doors and working with children while on her mission trips.

She is survived by two sons, Daniel Carrier and Kyle Carrier, both of Tacoma; her mother, Joy Horner, Wenatchee; three brothers and two sisters-in-law,
