Marcella "Marcy" Anna Sizemore, of East Wenatchee, WA, passed away on May 9, 2015, at her home in East Wenatchee, WA, where she lost her courageous battle with cancer. She was surrounded by her family until she went to be with our Lord.

Marcy was born in Eureka, South Dakota on March 14, 1934. She was adopted in 1943 by Franklin and Gertrude Rooney, owners of Rooney's Restaurant and Motor Lodge; between 1947 to 1969 at 821 N.
