After the death of her husband, she spent every morning walking at the river front meeting and visiting with everyone (dogs and humans) along the way. Always a coffee lover, later in life she was known to visit Denny's, Columbia at Pybus Market and finally Starbucks for her daily fix of coffee and visiting. She will be remembered for always having a friendly smile and hello to everyone.

(Phil), seven grandchildren and ten great-grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her parents, sisters: Mildred, Nellie, brother Tom, and grandson Cory.
