



## Marion Robinson

July 17, 1923 - December 12, 2017

Marion Elizabeth Robinson passed into eternal life on December 12, 2017 at the age of 94. She was born July 17, 1923 in Eramosa, Ontario to Emerson and Dinah Cripps. One of three kids, Marion moved to Simpson, Saskatchewan to live with her aunt and Uncle Ezera (E.B.) and Nellie Brown where she met her husband of 70 years John Robinson while working at E.B.'s gas station.

Upon John's return from WWII, she and the family moved to Vancouver, BC where John worked as a guard at the penitentiary and then in the fall of 1955 she and John moved to the Wenatchee Valley with their three children: Murray (Al), Lynne and Brian.

Marion worked at St. Anthony's Hospital and then left the hospital to support the families home construction business until the early 1980's.

In July of 2017 she retired from active Avon sales after 40 years.
