Martina Joan "JoAnn" Wiley, 80, a longtime Lakeview resident, passed away on Saturday evening, March 12, 2011 at Bonaventure in the Memory Care area.

She was born on July 15, 1930 at Clearfield, Iowa the only child born to Howard C. and Harriet (Bailey) Bush. As a young child, she moved with her family to Ephrata.
