



## Marveline Iris Bailey

July 29, 1929 - May 22, 2012

Marveline Iris Bailey, 82, a 25-year Wenatchee resident, passed away on Tuesday morning, May 22, 2012, at Central Washington Hospital.

She was born on July 30, 1929, at Yarmouth, Iowa, to the late Edward and Lulu (Coppas) Holsteen. She was raised in Yarmouth and graduated from Yarmouth High School. She continued her education at Moody Bible Institute in Chicago, Illinois. While studying there, she met Lloyd Wayne Bailey. They were later married on August 10, 1951, at Yarmouth, Iowa. Together they moved to Wheaton, Illinois, and following her husband's graduation from college, they moved to Castro Valley, California.
