June 22, 1928 - October 31, 2015

Mary Lee Fudge, 87, a Wenatchee resident for 69 years, passed away on Saturday, October 31, 2015 at Caring Cottage Adult Care Home in Wenatchee.

She was born on June 22, 1928 at Sage, Arkansas, to the late Clarence and Virgie (Campbell) Taylor. It was here she was raised and received her early schooling. Mary graduated from high school at Melbourne, Arkansas. On January 8, 1946 she married Verdell Truman Fudge, they moved to the Wenatchee area and settled in Baker Flats, later moving into town. Mary worked seasonally at Valley Evaporator where they made dried fruit.

Mary was a longtime member of the Church of Christ and later Kings Orchard Church of Christ. She enjoyed needlework, quilting, knitting, crocheting and reading.
